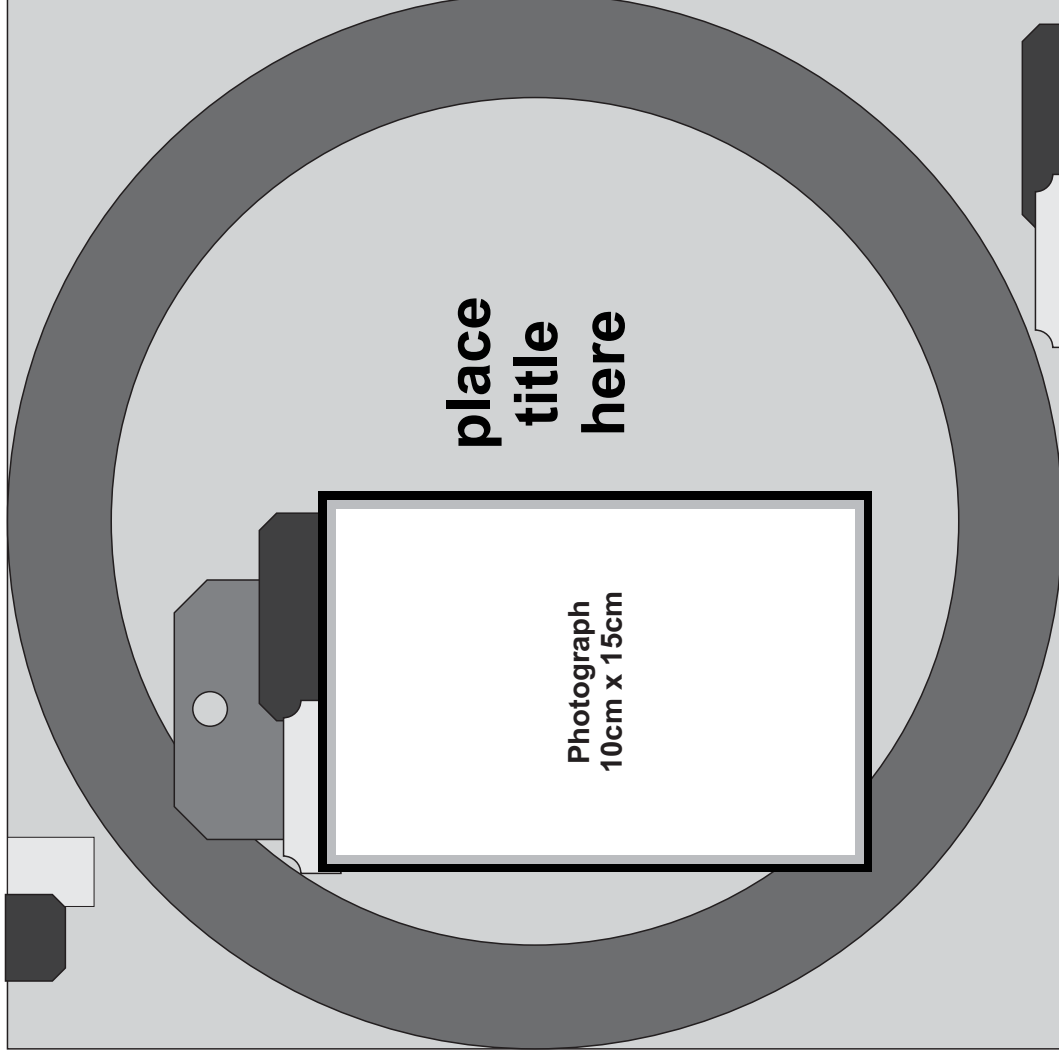

Supplies Needed:

1 plain base page
 1 x pattern paper - I used the wreath print
 if you don't have a wreath print - create a wreath using
 flowers and leaves
 1 Plain cardstock Dark
 1 Plain cardstock Light
 Embellishments, Sentiments, title
 Double sided tape and Wet adhesive
 Paper trimmer or Craft knife and metal ruler
 Self healing cutting mat
 Craft mat for inking
 Scissors
 Pencil and eraser
 Black / white gel ink pen
 Distress Oxide ink pad - Hickory Smoke, Victorian Velvet,
 Peeled paint
 Distress paint - Aged Mahogany, Spun Sugar
 White Acrylic Paint

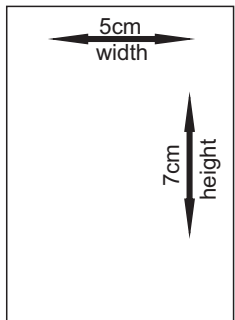
Photo Size Requirements:

1 @ 10cm x 15cm (P)

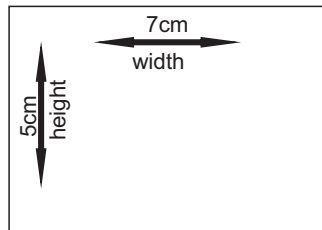
HELPFUL HINT:

How to use the cutting guide: The measurements are always given as width first and then height.

For example:
cut a piece to
measure 5cm x 7cm



For example:
cut a piece to
measure 7cm x 5cm



Creating the background

Trim .05cm from the top and the bottom of the pattern paper

Fussy cut the wreath along the outside and inside
Ink the edges of the grey print and attach back in place
on the base page.

Raise the flower wreath pattern using foam squares.

- when you are ready to attach it apply glue to the foam
squares - this will give you a chance to reposition the
wreath if you don't get it down in place.

Use the sketch for reference for placement of the photo
and embellishments

PHOTOGRAPHS

Crop 1 photo to measure 10cm x 15cm (P)

Out of the light cardstock cut 1 piece to
measure 10.5cm x 15.5cm and ink the edges.

Out of the dark cardstock cut 1 piece to
measure 11cm x 16cm and ink the edges

Ink the edges and then mat the photo onto the light
then onto the dark.

Lay the rest of the page out as in the example along
with the embellishments and title and attach everything
in place.
