



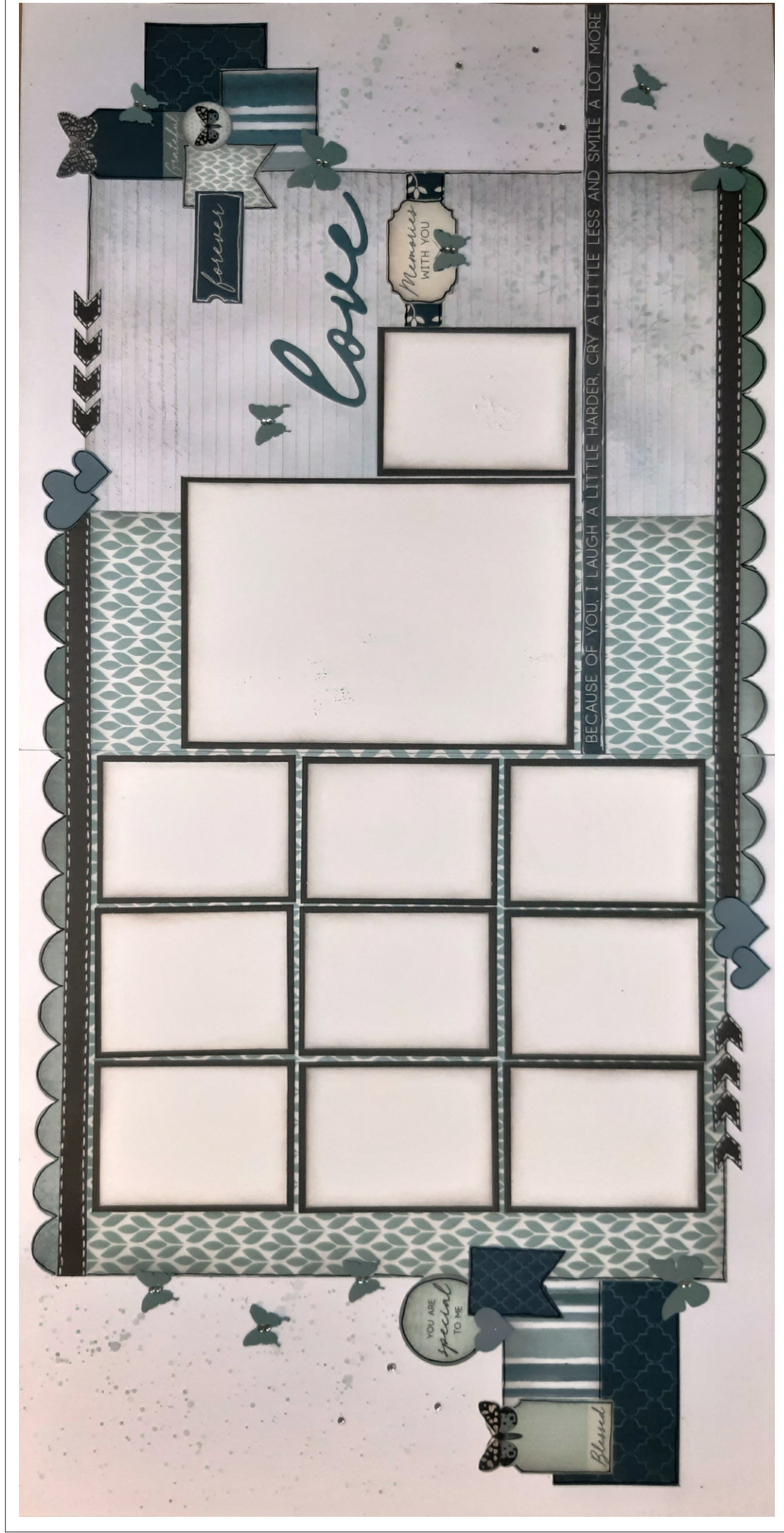

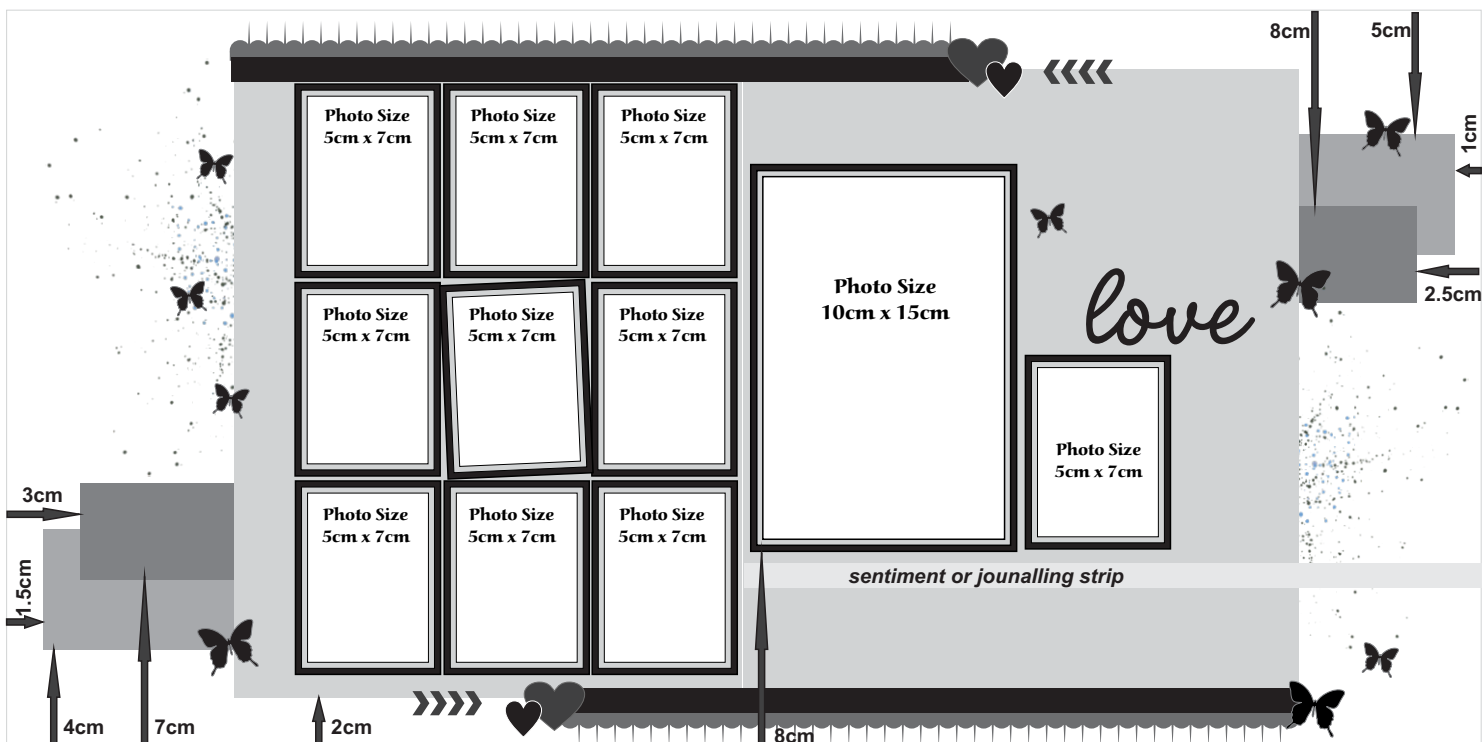

Supplies Needed:

3 - 4 different patterns
 2 plain or pattern for the background
 2 Plain cardstock Dark
 2 Plain cardstock Light
 Double sided tape,
 Wet adhesive
 Paper trimmer or
 Craft knife and metal ruler
 Self healing cutting mat
 Craft mat for inking
 Scissors
 Pencil and eraser
 Black gel ink pen
 White gel ink pen

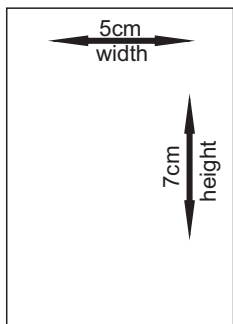
I also used distress oxide ink to ink the edges of my pattern papers.

To create the splatters I use a distress oxide ink colours which compliment the pattern paper. I painted the grey board embellishments with distress paint, you can use any type of acrylic paint to do this.

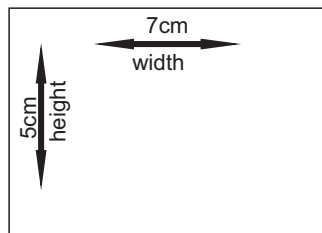
HELPFUL HINT:

How to use the cutting guide: The measurements are always given as width first and then height.

cut a piece to
measure 5cm x 7cm

Page Elements

Punch a scalloped border out of plain cardstock or another pattern, 2 @ 30.5cm x 2cm
Find an assortment of embellishments to compliment your photos and pattern paper

Photo Size Requirements:

1 @ 10cm x 15cm (P)
10 @ 5cm x 7cm (P)

Creating the background

I used 2 plain white cardstock for the background. To create the splatters, squish some distress ink oxide onto a craft mat and mist with water to create ink droplets. Use a paint brush to pick up the ink and flick onto the page - top left of the left side and bottom right of the right side of the plain cardstock - allow to dry, dab off excess ink.

Pattern Paper 1 - stripe

Cut 2 pieces to measure 10cm x 4cm and ink around the edges

Pattern 2 - morrocan print

Cut 2 pieces to measure 10cm x 5cm and ink around the edges

Pattern 3 -leaf print

Cut 1 piece to measure 21cm x 26cm - left
Ink around the edges - Only ink the top, left and bottom

Cut 1 piece to measure 23cm x 26cm - right
Ink around the edges - Only ink the top, right and bottom

Use the sketch for the placement of the patterns and adhere in place - you can draw lines around the edges now or wait until the project is complete

Before cutting the dark plain mats - cut 2 pieces to measure 30.5cm x 1cm

PHOTOGRAPHS

Crop 1 photo to measure 10cm x 15cm (P)
Out of the light cardstock cut 1 piece to measure 10.5cm x 15.5cm and ink the edges.
Out of the dark cardstock cut 1 piece to measure 11cm x 16cm and ink the edges
Ink the edges and then mat the photo onto the light then onto the dark

Crop 10 photos to measure 5cm x 7cm (P)
Out of the light cardstock cut 10 pieces to measure 5.5cm x 7.5cm and ink the edges.
Out of the dark cardstock cut 10 pieces to measure 6cm x 8cm and ink the edges
Ink the edges and then mat the photo onto the light then onto the dark.

Attach the 10 x 15 photo aprox. 8cm from the bottom right and approx. 2mm from the centre.

Attach the scalloped border to the top and bottom of of pattern paper 3.
Add the solid border as per the example.

Attach the small photo mats as in the example.

Lay the page out as in the example along with the embellishments and title and attach everything in place

Draw lines around the pattern paper, scalloped border and paper embellishments/die cuts.
Use a white gel pen to create fake stitches on the dark border strips
